



PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT and WAIVER **Camp Kawanhee Centennial Celebration**

The following guidelines are designed to insure that the Camp Kawanhee Centennial Celebration is a happy, safe, and productive experience for everyone. Here are the conditions under which we accept your participation. Read them carefully. All attendees are expected to adhere to the guidelines.

You will be asked to affirm your commitment to these guidelines by signing this form upon check-in at the reunion. Refusal to sign this form or violation of any of these policies may subject you to immediate dismissal from the reunion without a refund.

1. The Camp Kawanhee community relies upon each member making a positive contribution. Respect for others and self is required.
2. The Centennial Celebration will include alcohol at social hours on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings. Attendees age 21 and older are permitted to consume alcohol during designated times, and in designated areas only. Everyone is expected to consume responsibly and at all times to respect camp property, staff and all event participants.
3. No person age 21 or older may purchase or provide alcohol to any underage attendee.
4. No attendees under the age of 21 may consume at any time during the Centennial Celebration or bring alcohol onto Camp Kawanhee property.
5. The use or possession of marijuana, or any other controlled substances or drugs is not permitted at camp.
6. Tobacco use is permitted only in designated areas.
7. Weapons of any description, fireworks, and any other incendiaries are not permitted in camp.
8. Campfires must be lit, maintained and extinguished by designated individuals only.
9. Everyone must adhere to program area rules. Camp and event staff have authority in each respective area. Lakefront use is permitted in accordance to the safety and waterfront regulations attached. Ropes/Wall are off limits at all times unless otherwise indicated.
10. For the respect and enjoyment of all guests, camping and socializing is to occur in designated locations only.
11. Parents must accompany their children at all times.
12. Each attendee of the reunion is expected to contribute to keeping camp facilities neat and tidy by cleaning up after themselves and leaving their cabin at the end of the weekend as they found it upon arrival. Graffiti and other forms of vandalism are not tolerated.
13. Respect for indigenous animals and plants around camp and the natural environment in general is expected.

By signing this Waiver and Release of Liability (Agreement), I waive and release Camp Kawanhee, its agents, servants, employees, insurers, successors and assigns from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, damages or suits at law and equity of any kind, including but not limited to claims for personal injury, property damage, medical expenses, loss of services, on account of or in any way related to or growing out of my presence or involvement at the facility.

This waiver and release is intended to and does release Camp Kawanhee from any and all liability for damages or injuries on account of or in any way related to or growing out of my negligence, the negligence of third parties and Camp Kawanhee's negligence. This is not intended to release Camp Kawanhee from any liability resulting from their intentional conduct.

I further covenant and agree not to institute any claims or legal action against Camp Kawanhee for any claim released by this Agreement. I further agree that should any claim be made against Camp Kawanhee in contravention of this Agreement, including but not limited to derivative claims, I will protect, defend and completely indemnify (reimburse) Camp Kawanhee for any such claim and expenses including attorney's fees and costs incurred by Camp Kawanhee in defending themselves or security indemnity hereunder.

I understand that Camp Kawanhee is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged valuables or property.

I acknowledge that I have received and read the policies below and received and ready the Safety and Waterfront Regulations enclosed. I agree that I will fully comply with all rules and regulations and with any amendments.
