

COVID SAFETY

Camp Kawanhee Centennial Celebration

Based on our experiences this summer and our successful completion of a second COVID free summer, **we ask that all of our attendees complete a PCR or Rapid Antigen Covid test with negative results within 24 hours of their arrival at Kawanhee.** Any standard test – from at home tests to ones done at a clinic – are permitted.

Upon check-In, you will be asked to show us the results of this test, either with a picture or report on your phone, or a paper copy of the results. If you did not test, we will ask you to do so at check-in and will have a limited number of tests available for you to do that. If you have a positive result, are symptom free and are wondering if and/or when you might be able attend the event, we ask that you contact our camp nurse Sue Cook @207-585-2585 to discuss your individual circumstances.

It is our objective with this policy to be as conscientious as possible in running a safe event where the risk of an individual contracting COVID is minimal. In addition to this pre-arrival testing requirement, we are committed to holding all of our large group gatherings and meals outdoors and whenever possible with seating that allows for plenty of space between guests. In addition, we have a large supply of masks available for any guests who would like to wear them.
